



Class Use Tips

- You can teach one theme to all grades during the same school year to streamline planning or teach a different theme to each grade during the school year.
- If you teach one theme to all grades during the school year, choose another to teach the next year.
- Each theme lasts an entire school year and they can be done in any order!
- Themes are available for grades 3-4, 5-6, and 7-8.
- **The grade levels do not indicate Spanish experience**, but rather HOW the material is taught is suitable for children of that age/grade.
- **There is flexibility grouping students in your classes.** For example:
 - Use a grades 3-4 level with a class of 3rd-5th graders.
 - Use a grades 5-6 level with a class of 4th-6th graders.
 - Use a grades 7-8 level with a class of 6th-8th graders.
 - You can place a wider range of students together in one class. For example, you can use a grades 5-6 level with a group of grades 4-8 students.
 - It is 3rd grade that needs the grades 3-4 level the most. So, if you have a class with 3rd graders, you should use a grades 3-4 level with the whole class. Everyone will still learn the content of your chosen theme, but the grades 3-4 level will break things down more to accommodate for the 3rd graders.
- **You can place experienced Spanish for You! students and inexperienced students together at the beginning of a themed package.** Students who have had Spanish for You! will continue to build skill and knowledge while new students are seamlessly integrated.
