



Grade Levels Flexibility

- There are 6 school-year-long themed courses, each available in grade levels 3-4, 5-6, and 7-8.
- The grade levels are indicative of student developmental age/grade level in school, **not** Spanish experience.
- **There is a LOT of flexibility using the grade levels.**
 - **Examples:**
 - You can use a grades 3-4 level with 3rd-5th graders (ages 8-11).
 - You can use a grades 5-6 level with 4th-6th graders (ages 9-12).
 - You can use a grades 7-8 level with 6th-8th graders (ages 11-14).
 - **The grades 5-6 and 7-8 levels are very similar in how they teach and pace through the content. They generally can be used easily with grades 4-8 when you are trying to mix many ages together.**
 - The grades 3-4 level is most important for 3rd graders (age 8).
- **For K-2**, some teachers who are using the curriculum for their older students, pull content from it and create simple lessons for their younger students.
