


How to Use Spanish for You! for Classes

Step 1: Begin with the Week 1 One-Hour Lesson Plan

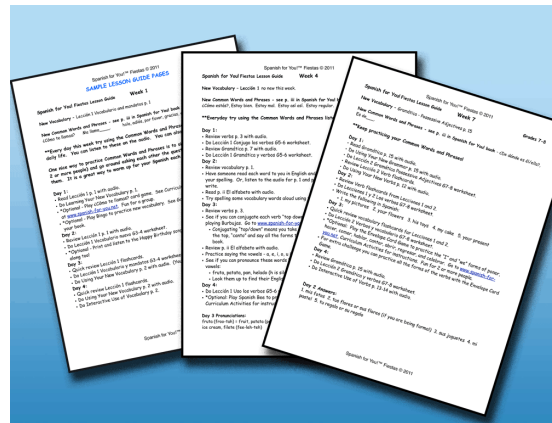
- Step-by-step easily taught activities.

Activity	Instructions	Materials
Warm up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Greet the students with "¡Hola, ¡Buenos días!" or "¡Buenos tardes!" Read aloud "¿Cómo estás?" (How are you?) (Bueno, mal, así así, regular) Give each student one card with a question, (questions below) Students move around room asking their question to three other students. The students must then answer the question in a full sentence. Practice a couple first. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have question and answer on board Index cards with one question per card one question card per student
Lesson Begins: Vocabulary Listening Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read the sentences below aloud and have students say "sí" or "no" if they make sense. 	sentences below
Listening and Speaking Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read the sentences below, saying "blanca" where there is a blank. Students raise hands to any vocabulary words that could fill the blank. 	sentences below
Dictate Sentences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have students use scrap paper or dry erase squares to write the sentences you read below. After dictating the sentences, write them on the board for students to check. 	scrap paper and pencil for each student or dry erase squares and markers
Listening and Writing Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students keep out scrap paper or dry erase squares. Read the sentences below and have students fill in the blank with the correct words in the correct form. Write the answers on board so students can self-check. Put these choices on board: sale, sales, pone, ponen, hace, hacen. 	scrap paper and pencil for each student or dry erase squares and markers
Play Bubbles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play Bubbles to practice conjugating "hablar" by heart. Go to www.spanish4you.com, Curriculum Activities for instructions. 	bottle of bubbles

Step 2: Follow With Week 1 Lesson Guide to use in class or as homework
